DIG

I lived and worked near Manchester on and off for nearly a year to research the local industrial archaeology and make the piece. There are disused collieries, canals which flow underground, an aqueduct and old canal boats. Some of these things I hope come through in the work, particularly a nearly extinct boat called a 'starvationer'. Its called this because of the external ribs of its construction. They were used to carry coal through narrow underground tunnels. People use Dig as a seating and performance area.
